Proposal for Continued Support and Extension of Project for 2019-2022

HIGHLIGHTS OF RISE

- **Better Learning Outcomes**

Marks were taken as the performance indicator for learning outcomes.

Start of Project ---- average marks of 500 children --- **18 % only**

Second Year ----- average marks of 500 children --- noticeable **improvement of 40%**

Third Year ----- average marks of 500 children --- again **increased to 60%**

- **Increase in School Attendance**

There has been a steady increase in school attendance of children covered under the RISE project.

Start of Project ---- average attendance of 500 children --- **60% attendance**

Second Year ----- average attendance of 500 children --- **rose to 75% attendance**

Third Year ----- average attendance of 500 children --- again **increased to 80%**

- **Decrease in Drop-Outs**

There has been a good decline of dropout rate of students attending RISE centre.

Start of Project ---- average drop out of 500 children --- **22 % (class 2 students)**

*Second Year ----- average drop out of 500 children --- **around 10 %**

*Third Year ----- average drop out of 500 children --- **still under accounts but declining from 2nd year**

**Even the children who migrated to other locations, continued with their schooling.*

- **Scholastic and Non Scholastic Improvement** in more than 500 children through Art, Craft, Yoga, Sports, Music and Dance activities

- **Holistic Development of children** through physical development through sports, and Nutritional Support, Psychological counselling for well-being.

- **Continuous capacity building of Educators** in new age Teaching Learning aids, Smart Teaching Techniques.

- **Skill Development of Educators** through ART & Craft Workshops, Legal, Financial and Digital Literacy.

- **Community awareness and mobilization** made hundreds of parents and lakhs of community members sensitised towards various social threats, opportunities, rights & duties.

- **Number Trend of marks, drop outs, attendance, Changed mind-sets, active and engaged community and increased demands of more and continued RISE centres** shows steady targets achieved by RISE.
